- Try to sit at the table as a family daily and share a meal together even if it's just to have a mug of tea or hot chocolate and a biscuit.
- Attend one of the reconciliation Masses

2nd Sunday Preparation for the Sacrament of Reconciliation

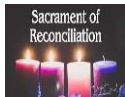
3rd Sunday Blessing of the Baby Jesus. Please bring the figure of baby Jesus to this weekend Mass

The Sacrament of Reconciliation

The Sacrament of Reconciliation (confessions) will be celebrated as a community on



Monday 16th December at 7.30pm in St Michael's church

Tuesday 17th and Wednesday 18th December at 7.30pm in the Church of the Assumption.

The evenings will begin with Mass with a nice atmosphere of prayer in the church. For many different reasons many people may have had a bad experience of confessions in the past or may find it difficult. On these evenings after the gospel parishioners will be invited to come forward, like at Holy Communion, and individually say to Fr Patrick 'I am sorry for my sin and I ask Gods forgiveness'. Fr Patrick will pray the prayer of absolution with you and you will return to your seat. For those who would like the traditional form of confession Fr. Patrick will be available after the Mass.

The Advent Challenge

We are encouraging households to come together each day of Advent to share at least one meal a day together- sitting at a table - The meal can be as simple as a cup of tea and a biscuit or a full meal - the important thing is coming together and having the chat about the day's events.

Rorate Mass

Takes place on Friday 20th of December at 6.00am in the Church of the Assumption. A Rorate Mass is traditionally celebrated just before dawn in Advent as a devotion to the Blessed Virgin Mary. The Mass is only lit by candles, symbolising Mary's role in bringing Jesus the Light of the World into the darkness of the world.



Christmas Mass Bouquets

These special cards are available from the parish office. They are nice to send to people who have been bereaved or people living abroad. Cards cost €10 and goes towards the support of the parish. The intentions will be remembered at Masses over the Christmas period.
