Parishioners and those with loved ones buried in our parish cemeteries -both living in the parish and living outside the parish; are invited to purchase or sell a book of tickets. The tickets cost €10 each with 12 tickets in a book. Those who sell a full book of tickets get to keep €20. There is a €100 prize for the seller of the winning ticket.

We are encouraging parishioners to sell tickets to family members who are connected to the parish and also to relations when they attend Cemetery Sunday or when they visit over the summer months.

All money from the 2026 Draw and the 2027 Draw will go towards resurfacing the driveway in Kill Cemetery, Jordanstown Cemetery and around the Church of the Assumption. If the money is raised, work on the cemeteries will commence in the summer of 2027. At the moment parts of the driveways are in a bad state of repair, not helped by cars driving up and down, the driveways we have been told have no foundations as they were really only meant for pedestrians rather than cars. The Parish Team have sought quotes for the project and at the moment it totals €110,000 to complete the project.

All families who have loved ones buried in the cemeteries or who hope to be buried in one of the parish Cemeteries are encouraged to buy or sell a book of tickets.
